

Looking for a special needs support person with sensory integration knowledge

I am looking for a person who could support a 5-year-old boy with special needs in his afterschool centre until the end of the school year.

S/he should shadow my son, following the regular activities organized by the class responsible, and helping him when required during group playtime or eating activities.

The schedule is flexible, approximately **Tuesday to Friday noon to five**. Contract will be through the family, salary to be discussed with interested.

Ideally, a last year **occupational therapist student with knowledge of sensory integration** who would like to shadow a child with a number of sensory challenges and communication difficulties.

I believe this experience can be an asset for any recent graduate in occupational therapy, as you could experience first-hand the difficulties of neurodiverse children at school and afterschool activities. I am confident this experience will turn into a unique skill when working in the future with young patients in a clinic.

It could be arranged with your university as an **internship**.

For others interested, sensory integration knowledge is a must. Empathy and lots of patience too :)
